Most of God's world is under the sea. We need to remember that Job tells us to "listen to fish in the ocean and they will tell you their stories".

3. Crafts

Messy Art - making a picture of an ocean.




How to. Cut a large piece of lining paper approximately 45 cm long. Take a sponge and cut the sponge up into 6cm squares approximately. Then find the paints you want to use to paint an ocean. Pour them onto some plates and wet the sponges. Now, one colour at a time, stroke across the paper. Covering two thirds of the paper with blue paint. With the yellow paint on the sponge, stroke the paper to create the bottom of the ocean. With a brush paint some seaweed growing up from the bottom of the seabed.




Put on one side to dry.


Why. The ocean is all part of God's creation. It is teeming with and full of different creatures like fish, sea snails and large whales. Among other things, like the plastic in the ocean, we need to think about how we can help with looking after the Coral Reefs which are changing. Many of the tropical fish that live in Coral Reefs are under threat. All of God's world is precious.

- c) The answers are at the bottom of this session.
- d) Now colour in all the Pictures
- e) Then cut them out.

Why. All the teeming creatures of the oceans are important to God. As Job says we need to listen to their stories, help them and learn from them. We don't want to pollute the sea creatures and ourselves with our rubbish.





How to. Take

each cut out image and stick it onto your ocean pictures. Ask yourself where does the creature live: at the bottom or the top of the ocean?

Why. Now we have a picture that will remind us that God loves all his creatures He created in the world. WE need to Pass on his love to all the creatures in his world, **The Blue Planet.**

5. Prayer. Take a bowl of water and place it on a table.

- Stir the bowl of water and watch the swirl go around. Think of God and the oceans.
- Stir the bowl of water and watch it swirl around. Pray to God to fill us with love and appreciation of the oceans' environment and creatures in the sea.
- Stir the bowl of water and watch it swirl around. Ask for the Holy Spirit to give us ideas how to protect and preserve the oceans.
- Then pass the prayer on to another member of your family and ask them to do the same.

NB Did you know the oceans and water in a basin when draining go around in a different direction south of the equator?

Challenge of the week for those who like reading: go on the Ocean Day website and learn more about your oceans.






